CRMU Making Plans for Removal of Sludge from Lagoons

CRMU's wastewater is treated by facultative waste stabilization ponds, sometimes referred to as lagoons, located southeast of town.

While the facultative lagoon concept is land intensive, it offers a reliable and easy-to-operate process that is very attractive to small, rural communities.

Although simplistic in appearance, the reactions in a facultative pond system are as complicated as any other treatment process. Facultative lagoons accumulate sludge and inert materials as a natural byproduct of anaerobic digestion. This dead microbial material "sludge" which accumulates over many years in the bottom of lagoons, periodically must be removed from the lagoons.



CRMU's lagoons were constructed in 1977 and have never had the sludge removed yet. As a rule of thumb, the IDNR typically recommends cleaning of lagoons when the solids are approaching 30% of design capacity—which CRMU has obtained.

CRMU is currently evaluating cost effective options for the removal of the sludge. The two primary options for removal are dredging and/or pumping of the solids, and draining the lagoons and mechanically removing the material with excavation equipment.
