10. _____ Customer signs Agreement for Electric Service and Interconnection and pays installation fees.
 - A. _____ Customer provides CRMU a copy of \$1,000,000 liability insurance policy with CRMU named as an additional insured.
11. _____ Customer proceeds with installation. Upon completion of installation - customer submits "Certificate of Completion" to CRMU.
12. _____ CRMU inspects QF facility and issues "Approval to Energize Generating Facility" to customer.
